The school has a strong commitment to inclusion, which means we have a wide variety of courses that offer different styles of learning and assessment. We use the International Baccalaureate (IB) Middle Years Programme (MYP) for Years 7 to 9, and the International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) for Years 10 and 11. Beyond that, we have several routes to success for our Years 12 and 13 – the IB Diploma; the IB Career-related Programme (IBCP); and Business and Technology Education Council (BTEC) courses. Whichever path you choose, we promise all students a high-quality international education.

Our focus on knowing students as individuals and nurturing their unique talents and interests builds a secure foundation for success from a young age. Each student is assigned to a tutor group, which they stay with throughout their time at West Island School. Students have regular one-to-one sessions with their tutor to develop their own personalised learning programmes.

Our school campus in Pokfulam is nestled in green hillsides overlooking the South China Sea. The architecturally-designed, purpose-built premises covers an impressive ten-storey building, with four blocks of classrooms, laboratories, a library, and three cafeterias. We also have a performance space for drama and dance, design technology workshops including areas for learning about food and textiles, and studios for the further exploration of art and music. We offer a range of sports at our indoor pool and on our outdoor courts.
